EXHIBITOR AND OBSERVER GUIDELINES DURING JUDGING

During judging, exhibitors and non-participating observers are permitted to watch the judge making his or her decisions. However, exhibitors and observers are not to interrupt the judging in process. Questions may be asked of the superintendent after the class has been judged, and then the judge is to explain the process in question. If you interrupt during judging, your entries in that department will be disqualified and all your entries in the fair may be disqualified.

DEPARTMENT 218 - CULTURAL ARTS

- All articles exhibited must have been made by the exhibitor and finished during the year, and not been previously exhibited at this fair. All pictures must be matted (no frames allowed) and have provision for hanging on pegboard hooks.
- No exhibitor will be paid more than one premium under any lot number. In case there is but one entry under any lot number, judges will award premium according to merit of the article on display.

PAINTING

Paint by number kits or similar kits will not be eligible. All pictures must be matted (no frames allowed) and have provisions for hanging on pegboard hooks.
